Vote Early in Person


SEPTEMBER 18-OCTOBER 31

Bring ID and vote early in person at your local registrar's office or satellite Absentee Voting location (if available). Any Virginia voter may vote early and no application is needed. Curbside voting and accessible voting equipment are available by request.



Vote Absentee by Mail

SEPTEMBER 18-NOVEMBER 3





Alternatively, you may return your completed absentee ballot in person to the registrar's office or satellite Absentee Voting location (if available) by 7pm on Nov. 3rd. A courier service or another person may not deliver it for you.



Vote in Person on Election Day

NOVEMBER 3



Bring an ID and vote in person between 6 am and 7 pm on Nov. 3rd at your designated polling place. If you are in line by 7 pm, you are allowed to vote by law. If you are turned away from a polling place, request a provisional ballot. Curbside voting and accessible voting equipment are available by request.
