

REMEMBER TO VOTE!

Tuesday, Nov. 8, is Election Day, a state holiday in Virginia.

- On Virginia ballots will be U.S. House of Representatives and local races
- Visit <u>VOTE411.org</u>, LWV's nonpartisan voters' guide, to view your ballot and candidates' position statements

Vote early at your registrar or satellite office by Nov. 5

- Request a mail-in ballot until Oct. 28 and return it by mail or in person to your local voter registration office by 7 p.m. on Nov. 8
 - Mailed ballot must be postmarked by Nov. 8 and received by noon on Nov. 14
 - Check with your registrar for details

Vote at your polling place 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Nov. 8

Go to <u>Citizen Portal</u> or <u>elections.virginia.gov</u> to request a mail-in ballot, find your registrar or polling place, see accepted ID's & more
