

VOTING IS POWER

Vote Early! (In person or by mail)

Election day is November 7, 2023. Make a plan.

- Visit <u>VPAP.org</u>, the Virginia Public Access Project, or <u>VOTE411.org</u>, LWV's nonpartisan voters' guide, to view your ballot and candidates' position statements.
- Visit <u>Who's My Legislator</u> at <u>https://whosmy.virginiageneralassembly.gov/</u> to see your new districts.

Register to vote or update your registration online or in-person by **October 16.**

Request a mail-in ballot online or by mail until October 27.

- Return the ballot by mail or in person to your registrar or polling place by November 7.
- Mailed ballot must be postmarked by November 7 and received by noon on November 13.
- Be sure to sign your ballot! (Witness signature is no longer required.)

Vote early at your registrar or satellite office starting Sept. 22

• Vote in-person at your polling place 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. November 7.
