

June 17, 2025 Primary

There will be a primary for any contested seats in the Virginia House of Delegates, some local races, and possibly for Governor, Lt. Governor, and Attorney General on June 17, 2025.

Registering to Vote and Updating Your Registration

You may register to vote until May 27, 2025. If you have a Virginia driver's license, you can do so at <u>https://www.elections.virginia.gov/citizen-portal</u>.

You can download a paper application at <u>https://www.elections.virginia.gov</u>.

After May 27 you may not register online but must go to your early voting site or polling place to register, and then vote a provisional ballot.

Anyone who is 17 but will be 18 on or before Nov. 4, 2025 can register to vote in this primary.

Early Voting

Early Voting begins on May 2, 2025 and goes through 5 PM Saturday, June 14, 2025. There will be Saturday voting on June 7, 2025. To find specific voting locations and times, find your local registrar at https://vote.elections.virginia.gov/VoterInformation/PublicContactLookup.

Vote by Mail or Drop Box

The last day to apply for an absentee ballot is on June 6, 2025 by 5 PM. Apply at <u>https://www.elections.virginia.gov/citizen-portal</u>. Find drop boxes at your local registrar's page.

Election Day

Polls open from 6 AM - 7 PM on Election Day June 17, 2025. To find proper voter ID, go to <u>https://www.elections.virginia.gov/registration/voterid</u>.
