



## REFERENDUM

### Statewide Issue: Redistricting

### April 21, 2026

A statewide election has been set to put a referendum of proposed new Congressional districts to a popular vote. **Polls will be open from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m.** The question on the ballot is:

*Should the Constitution of Virginia be amended to allow the General Assembly to temporarily adopt new congressional districts to restore fairness in the upcoming elections, while ensuring Virginia's standard redistricting process resumes for all future redistricting after the 2030 census?*

Use the VA Elections Citizen Portal, [www.elections.virginia.gov/citizen-portal](http://www.elections.virginia.gov/citizen-portal), to:

- Register to vote or update your registration by April 14.
- Find in-person voting sites for early voting open between March 6 - April 18.
- Request a mail-in ballot by 5 p.m. on April 10.
- Return your absentee ballot to a polling site or by mail postmarked by April 21.
  - **AVOID DELAYS!** Return your ballot by mail early, request a postmark at the Post Office, or return the ballot in person.
  - To find early voting and ballot drop box locations, contact your local registrar's office: Chesterfield (804-748-1471), Hanover (804-365-6080), Henrico (804-501-4347), or Richmond (804-646-5956).
- Register and vote using a provisional ballot in person April 15 through April 21.
