



VOTING IS POWER

Election day is November 3, 2026.

Polls will be open from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Make a plan and know your ballot.

On the ballot: U.S. Senate, U.S. House, local offices, plus three Virginia Constitutional amendments: the right to reproductive freedom, right to vote, and marriage equality.

Visit Vote411.org to learn more about the candidates and print a sample ballot including the constitutional amendments.

Use the VA Elections **Citizen Portal**, www.elections.virginia.gov/citizen-portal, to:

- Register to vote or update your registration by October 23.
- Request a mail-in ballot by 5 p.m. on October 23.

Return your ballot to a drop box or your polling place by November 3. Mailed ballots must be received by noon on November 6.

- **AVOID LATE OR LOST BALLOTS!** Return your ballot by mail early, request a postmark at the Post Office, or return the ballot in person.

Early voting is available September 18 through October 31. Register and vote on the same day using a provisional ballot after October 23 through November 3.
